Guidelines to using the Intellectual Property – Student Policy

Q.1 Are you also a UCOL employee?

- If yes, obtain and apply “Intellectual Property - Staff Policy” and disregard the Student Policy.
- If the answer is no, go to Question 2.

Q.2 Did you create the Work by yourself

- without funding from UCOL or elsewhere,
- without supervision from UCOL or elsewhere,
- without using UCOL equipment or facilities, and
- without using an existing Work?

If the answer is yes to each of these questions go to Policy Statement 1.1 of the Intellectual Property – Student Policy.

If the answer is no to any of these items then either UCOL or a third party will own the Intellectual Property Rights in the Work and Policy Statement 1.2 applies. Refer to all the Policy Statements in the Intellectual Property – Student Policy for further information.
